

Customer Instructions Brush Hog



Warning:

Customer is responsible for all damage to equipment.

All Customers must leave a \$300 refundable deposit in addition to the rental, to cover any damages.

Always wear eye protection, close fitting clothing and tight fitting gloves. Remove all jewelry, esp. dangling necklaces. Hearing protection is recommended. Do not stick hands or feet under deck while brush hog is running.

Walk the lot to be cleared prior to using the Brush Hog, and remove rocks, stumps and other obstacles that may damage the machine. The Brush Hog is intended to cut down weeds and brush; it will not cut down trees.

Operating Instructions

1. Throttle down the tractor to low speed before pulling the yellow button, which engages the PTO for the Brush Hog. Failure to do throttle down will shear the Safety Pin, and could cause serious damage to the Brush Hog or tractor.
2. Bring the throttle up on the tractor until the the RPM arrow is in-line with the yellow PTO diagram, which is the maximum RPM for the Brush Hog.
3. Raise & lower the Brush Hog with the lever next to the seat on operator's right. Pushing the lever forward will lower the Brush Hog, and pulling the lever back will raise the Brush Hog.
4. Adjust your speed to the thickness of weeds and the height of the brush.
5. When making tight turns with the tractor & Brush Hog, lower the tractor RPM, and push in the yellow button to disengage the Brush Hog, then lift it. Make the turn, then lower the Brush Hog, engage the PTO and increase the RPM to the yellow PTO diagram on the console.
6. Never raise the Brush Hog at full RPM. Doing so will throw debris out from under the Brush Hog at a high rate of speed and may cause injury or damage.
