

# Customer Instructions

## Cold Water Pressure Washer



**Warning: NEVER PLACE HANDS OR FINGERS IN FRONT OF NOZZLE, NEVER AIM WAND AT PEOPLE. NEVER touch muffler, as its surface may exceed 150° and will cause burns. Use eye protection when using a pressure washer. Use unleaded fuel ONLY. NEVER use bleach in a pressure washer.**

### Operating Instructions

1. Hook up a garden hose to the unit. For easier starting, hold the handle on the spray gun open to release the pressure from the pump. Never run the pressure washer without a nozzle properly installed on the end of the gun. To start the engine, turn the on/off switch to "on," turn the fuel on, move the choke lever to "start." Pull the recoil rope to start the engine, and when it starts move the choke lever to the "run" position.
2. Test the pressure washer for the result you want to achieve. The best way is to start spraying 3 or 4 feet away from the object. Move the wand from side to side while you spray, then check to see if the surface is clean. If additional cleaning is needed, move your wand **gradually** closer to the surface until the desired result is achieved. Pressure washers are extremely powerful, and if you start too close to the object, damage may occur. Use of a ladder with a pressure washer is NOT recommended as the recoil from the pressure may knock you off the ladder.
3. Be sure to cover any electrical outlets in the area you are spraying.

Description of Nozzles and applications:

- A. **RED** (0°) Blasting Nozzle-used to remove weeds from sidewalk cracks, or stubborn stains from concrete, masonry, aluminum & steel
- B. **YELLOW** (15°) Chiseling Nozzle-used for surface preparation, removing mildew, stains & loose paint.
- C. **GREEN** (25°) Flushing Nozzle-used to sweep leaves from walks, curbs & driveways, cleaning stables, washing swimming pool floors and walls & degreasing engines.
- D. **WHITE** (40°) Wash Nozzle-used to wash down aluminum siding, cleaning windows, washing vehicles, spraying sidewalks, driveways & patios.
